# FORD LAND RENOVATIONS

Stenco recently completed two different office renovations for Ford Land, aimed at modernizing and brightening the workspaces, in Dearborn and Allen Park, Michigan.

The property in Dearborn was a General Contracting package that required complete demolition and reconstruction in a 12 week time frame and was completed in December 2015. This 60,000 sq. ft. renovation transitioned the building from separate spaces to an open concept layout, and included the remodeling of six restrooms, multiple collaboration spaces, and three kitchenettes, which included demolition and excavation for sewer tie ins. Stenco self performed all metal stud framing, drywall installation and finishing, doors, frames, and hardware, and acoustical ceiling rework. To finish the space, new furniture, architectural ceiling clouds, and a vibrant color scheme were used to increase communication and collaboration among employees.

The property in Allen Park was a 27,000 sq. ft. office renovation that also had a very aggressive schedule to complete, with a 12 week window from time of award to final turn over. This project included complete demolition of interior office walls, restrooms, electrical systems, and HVAC system rework. A new kitchenette area, four new restrooms, and several new open concept office areas were constructed. The new restrooms were relocated within the suite requiring extensive concrete floor demolition and underground plumbing relocation. The renovation also included areas of new suspended ceiling with ceiling tile replacement throughout the suite. Painting and door refinishing gave the suite, which was completed in February 2016, its modern final touches.

Coordination and communication with the owners, architects, suppliers, and subcontractors was critical to maintain this strict schedule and customer satisfaction on both these projects. Stenco is pleased to be a part of these exciting remodels, and looks forward to future opportunities partnering with Ford.


