Michigan Veterans Foundation

In May, Stenco was awarded the General Trades package for the new Michigan Veterans Foundation (MVF) Headquarters in Detroit. This project came into development after MVF sold their previous space to make room for the new Little Caesars Arena and Wayne State University Business School.

The 50,000 sq. ft. MVF center will house roughly 120 veterans and will include a full service cafeteria and dining room, a comprehensive fitness center, laundry facilities, and even a small public museum. It will also include a chapel, therapy rooms, a library, conference rooms, and offices.

Stenco is currently self performing all of the metal stud framing, drywall installation, and doors and hardware, and is installing all acoustical ceilings throughout the building. In addition, the team is setting 350 metal roof trusses, installing 18,000 sq. ft. of roof sheathing, and hanging 10,000 sq. ft. of Hardie siding to complete the space. The crew is currently on pace to meet the aggressive schedule with a December completion date.

MVF's mission is to provide an array of services to those veterans that need assistance regaining stability and self sufficiency after combat. We are pleased to take part in completing this new facility to help MVF further their goals in supporting Michigan's former servicemen and women.
